SEED GRANT AWARDED TO LOCAL BUSINESSWOMAN

SPARTA – (August 25, 2010) – Local businesswoman, Sherri Putnam of Sparta, was awarded 1st place honors in NJAWBO's Women's Business Center's S.E.E.D. Grant competition for her business, HCI Consulting, LLC, which specializes in the implementation, training, and support of NextGen Healthcare Information Systems Electronic Health Records and practice management software.
